School provide a PE top and shorts however parents are asked to ensure their child has trainers or plimsolls in school all of the time. It is also worth checking now and then that these still fit!

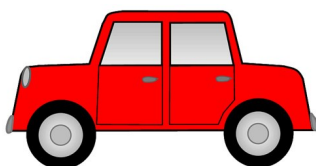
We have a number of children repeatedly asking to borrow spare plimsolls, and we only have a few.
